

#### 2 About the Norwegian Defence Materiel Agency

This request for information is carried out by the Norwegian Defence Materiel Agency (NDMA). NDMA shall ensure that the Norwegian Armed Forces and other undertakings in the defence sector gain access to cost-efficient, safe materiel in accordance with adopted long-term plans. NDMA's main tasks are to plan, procure, manage and sell materiel for the Armed Forces, and other agencies organised under the Ministry of Defence. NDMA is the technical competent authority in certain areas and provides the Ministry of Defence, the Armed Forces and other parts of the sector with advice and expertise within the agency's area of responsibility. NDMA also follows up international materiel cooperation and assists the Ministry in the marketing of Norwegian industry. NDMA has approximately 1,300 employees, 60% of whom are civil employees and the rest military. NDMA is managed by a managing director and organised as one staff unit and five divisions.



This RFI is accomplished by NDMA Land Systems. NDLO Land Systems is responsible for the accomplishment of all material investments in the area of land based systems, including vehicles, engineers' materiel, weapons and sensors for the Norwegian Armed Forces, and also supports other units within the Norwegian Armed Forces in accomplishing procurements. #### 3 The request for information

#### 3.1 Purpose

The purpose of this Request for Information (RFI) is to provide the Norwegian Defence Materiel Agency with a more in-depth knowledge of the market with respect to potential suppliers, technical performance, price and lead-time for delivery etc. The gathered information will be used to determine the project feasibility as well as to define the projects technical and functional requirements, budget and time frame. This RFI does not in any way commit the NDMA to make a later procurement and any costs relating to this RFI-reply will not be reimbursed.

#### 3.3 Language requirements

All written and oral communication in connection with this RFI-procedure shall be conducted in Norwegian or English. The language requirement also applies to the RFI-replies as such.

#### 3.4 Elaborations and clarification of replies

The NDMA may contact RFI-repliers' to elaborate and/or clarify replies.

#### 3.5 Test of systems

The NDMA may agree with RFI-repliers and/or their collaborating partners inspect, test and/or verify RFI submitted systems. Only the systems' with high and/or relatively high need coverage for the NDMA will be prioritized, cf. section 4 *The system and its operational scope* in particular. Non-compliance with preliminary shall-requirements will at this RFI-stage not alone decide a systems' prioritization.

#### 3.6 The Freedom of information Act

The procurement will ensure the Norwegian Armed Forces (NAF) with the capability to engage enemy material, light armoured vehicles, unarmoured vehicles on a longer distance. The rifle with its sub-systems will ensure NAF's ability to perform in high intensity act of conflict with sustainability over time. In a national and international environment.
